## **School Reminders:**

- Please ensure that the school has up to date contact numbers in the event of illness/accidents and the possibility of school closure due to severe weather.*
- At Ae Primary we provide early access from 8.15am to accommodate our parents/carers who need that extra time to commute to their workplace or, on occasion, have to attend an early morning appointment. A member of staff should always be in the school building from 8.15am.*
